

## 2018 ASC Spring Referee Meeting Agenda – In-Town Referee Meeting

1. Check-in. Handout t-shirts and packets.
2. Code of Conduct and Game Day Reminders
3. Game assignments – All referees input availability (by Sunday night for the following weekend) and accept/reject games at [www.usofficials.com](http://www.usofficials.com)
4. Game reports (and payment) – Complete within 24 hours of the game.

All In-town games are reported at [www.usofficials.com](http://www.usofficials.com). Payment for In-town Referees happens about three times each season and should happen automatically if you have entered game reports on [www.usofficials.com](http://www.usofficials.com). In-town referees are reimbursed \$20 per game.

  - Under no circumstances should a referee submit a game report for a game he/she doesn't do - it is harder to change once report is submitted.
5. Review Rules for In-Town games. Discuss differences between age groups and between Grade 8 games.
  - Find as many rule differences as you can between Grade 8 (ones you play) games and Grades 3 and 4 in-town games.
  - Find as many rule differences as you can between Grade 2 intown games and Grades 3 and 4 in-town games.
6. Changes in Rules – see ASC website Referee/Resources section for all changes in the Laws of the Game.

Kickoff can go in any direction, including backwards and must clearly move. Because of that, all players must be in their own half at kickoff except the kicker who can be in the offensive half but should be within a playable distance of the ball.

If a dropped ball enters the goal without touching at least 2 players (same as an indirect free kick), restart (for the opponent) is either a goal kick if it goes in the opponent's goal or a corner kick if it goes in team who kicked its goal.
