- 3. Masks will be required by all players, coaches and referees while at the field area. Referees should check for mask compliance during the safety check at team check-in and during the game.
- 4. Game assignments All referees input availability (by Sunday night for the following weekend) and accept/reject games at www.usofficials.com by Wednesday at the latest (preferably Tuesday). On Thursday Paul sends an email with any games not yet filled. Please email him directly if you are responding to one of his Thursday emails.
- 5. Game reports (and payment) Complete within 24 hours of the game.

All In-town games are reported at www.usofficials.com. Payment for In-town Referees happens by check about three times each season and should happen automatically if you have entered game reports on www.usofficials.com. In-town referees are reimbursed \$25 per game.
